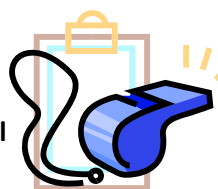

Sport Team Notes

Varsity Football: The varsity football team beat Coastal Christian Prep School Friday, September 25, 2009 which marks the first conference win in school history. The Generals defeated the Cougars 35-0. Sophomore Quarterback Jordan Marsh broke his own previous single season record for passing yards in a single game by throwing for 310 yards. He also threw 3 Touchdown's. The JV Team continues to improve. The team has had several exciting wins this year. **Also**, the Football Coaches want to encourage you to come on the game field after games to be a part of prayer and the Coach's Remarks at all home football games. We will also invite you out at away games if permitted.

Cross Country: The cross country team has participated in numerous meets in the Charleston area this year. They are under the direction of first year coach **Anne Clinton**, who previously ran cross country and track at The Florida State University. Every team member has broken their own personal record time this season for the 3.1 mile race. They will compete in the SCISA A-AA State Championship Meet on October 31st at Heathwood Hall in Columbia, SC.

Volleyball: The team is coached by first year coach **Mike Wolter** who is a former Junior Olympics volleyball player. Coach Wolter looks to build the program into a powerhouse and is already in the works of forming a club volleyball team in the North Charleston area. The volleyball team has suffered a couple of injuries, but is looking to finish the season strong heading into the Region Tournament at the end of the month. The Region Tournament will be held in Savannah, GA. The JV Team has also enjoyed wins this year as they continue to build confidence and skills for the future.

Cheer: The Cheerleaders have also been working hard since August. They are gearing up for Competition Cheer in the winter and spring. A JV Cheer Squad will start with basketball season. Our Junior Cheer Squad was a big hit at our last football game. You will definitely see them again!
