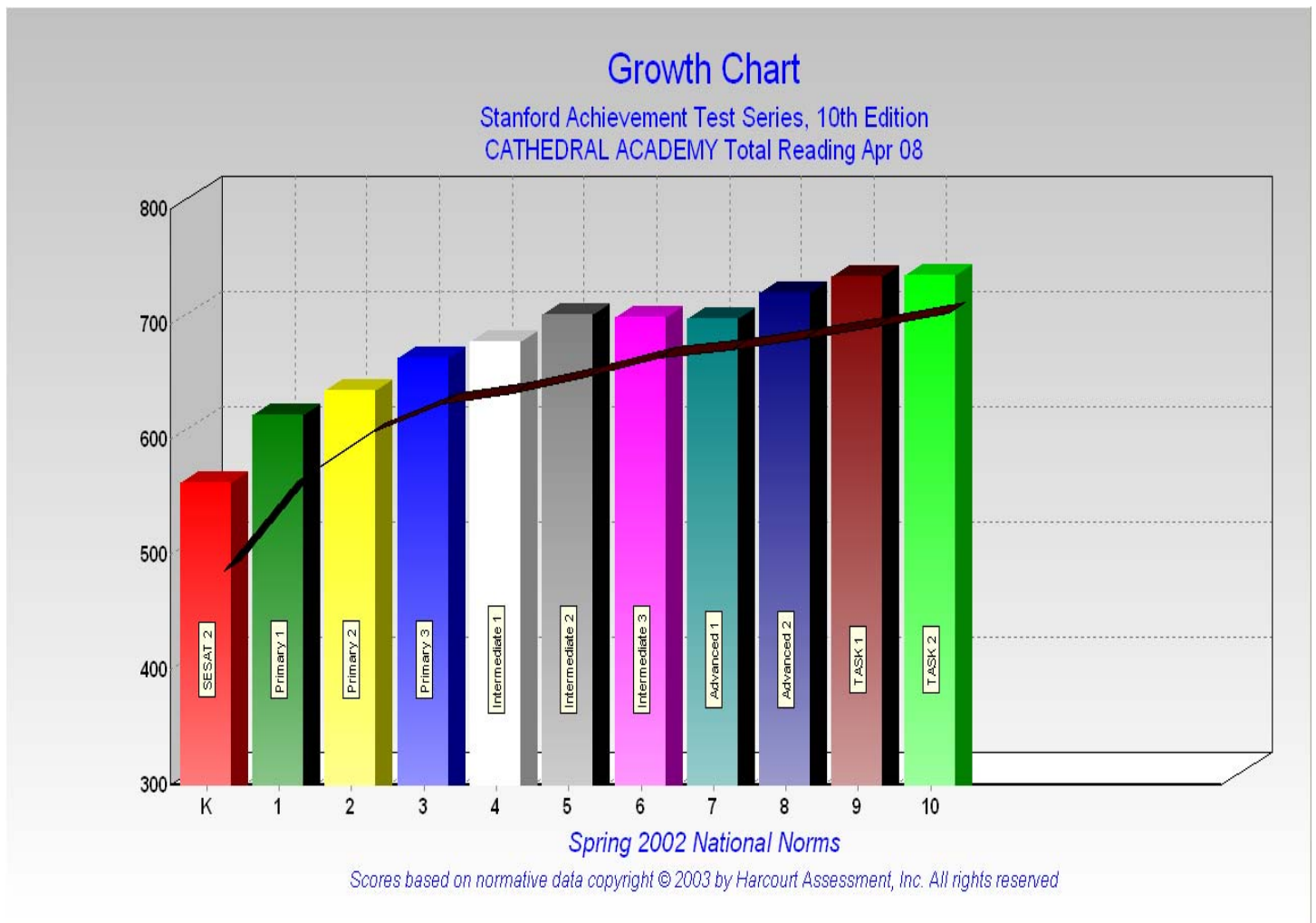


Stanford 10 Testing Data

Growth Charts

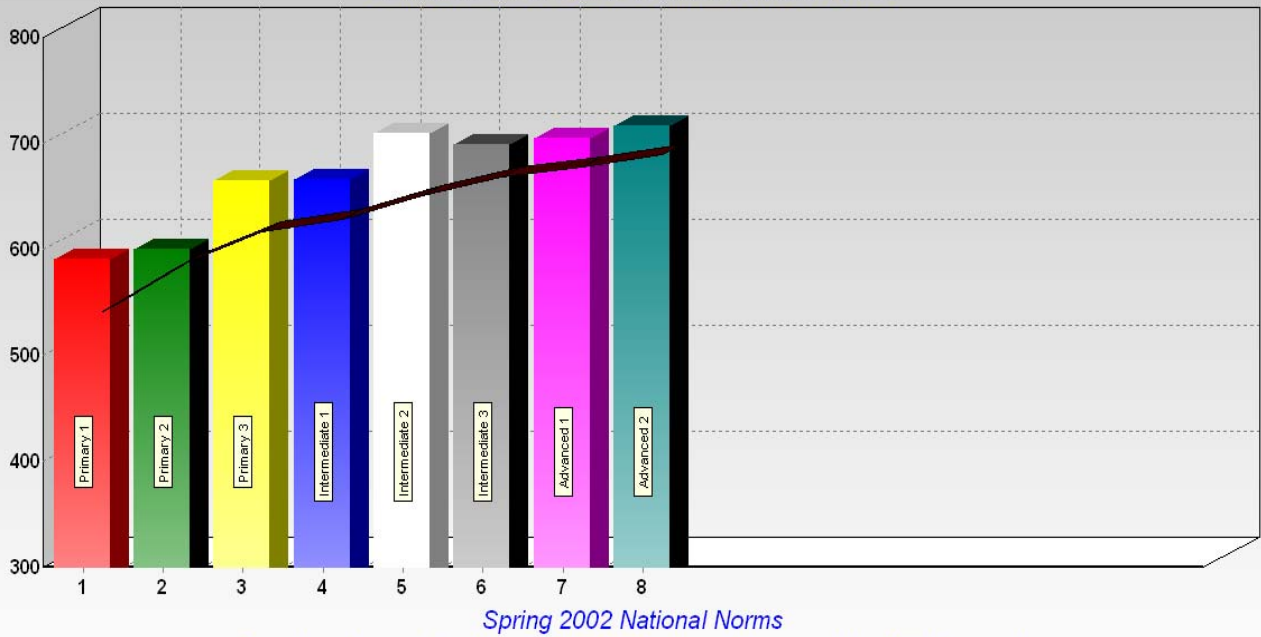
The Stanford Test, given in the Spring of the school year, is a Nationally Norm Referenced Test. It gives us a picture of how we compare to other students across the nation.

The **Black Line** on each graph indicates where the National Averages are for 2009. As you can see, CA's scores are above that mark.

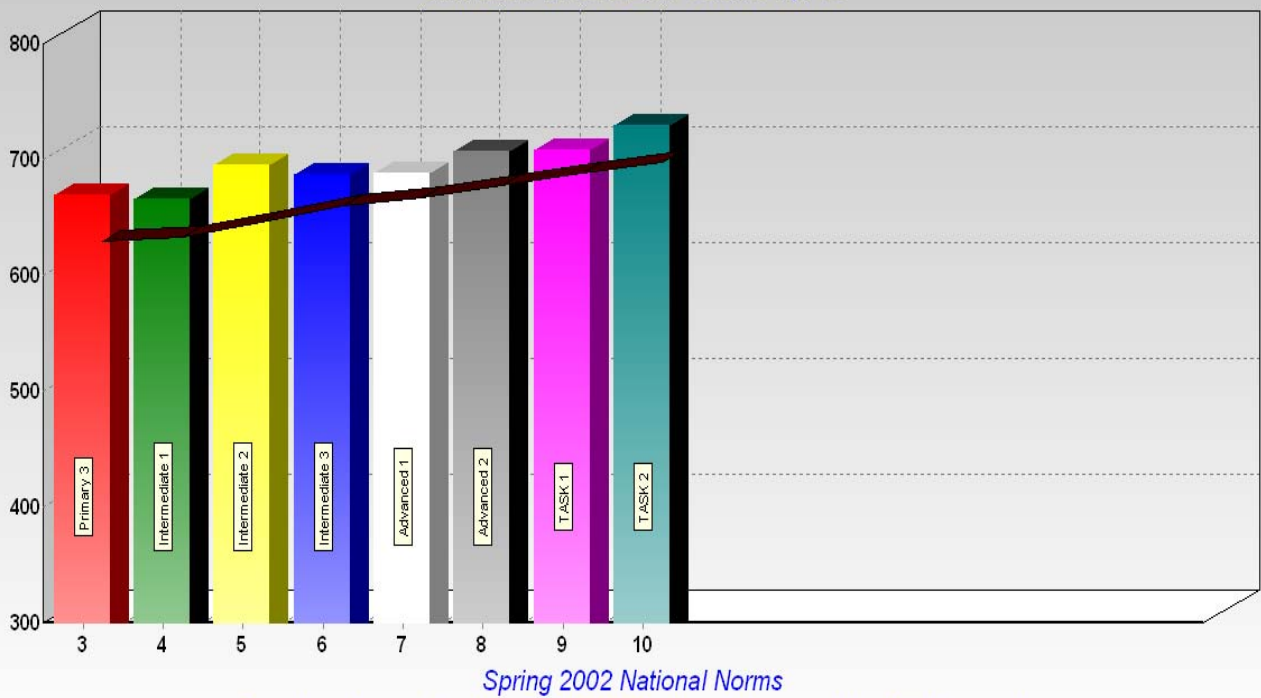

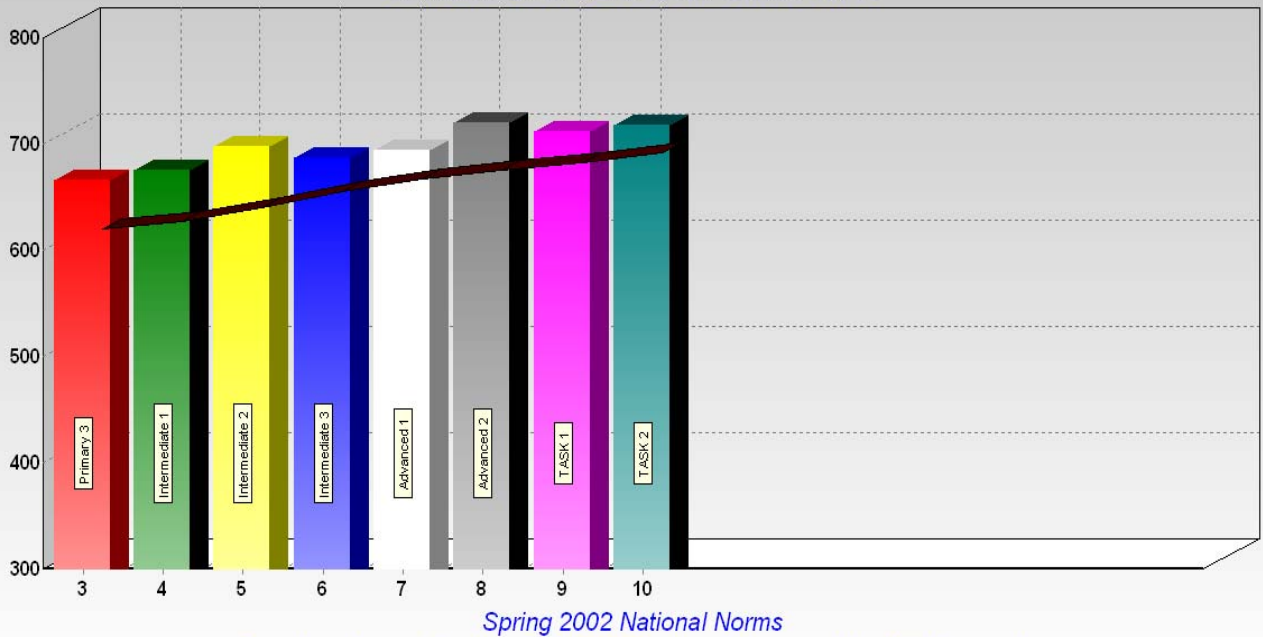

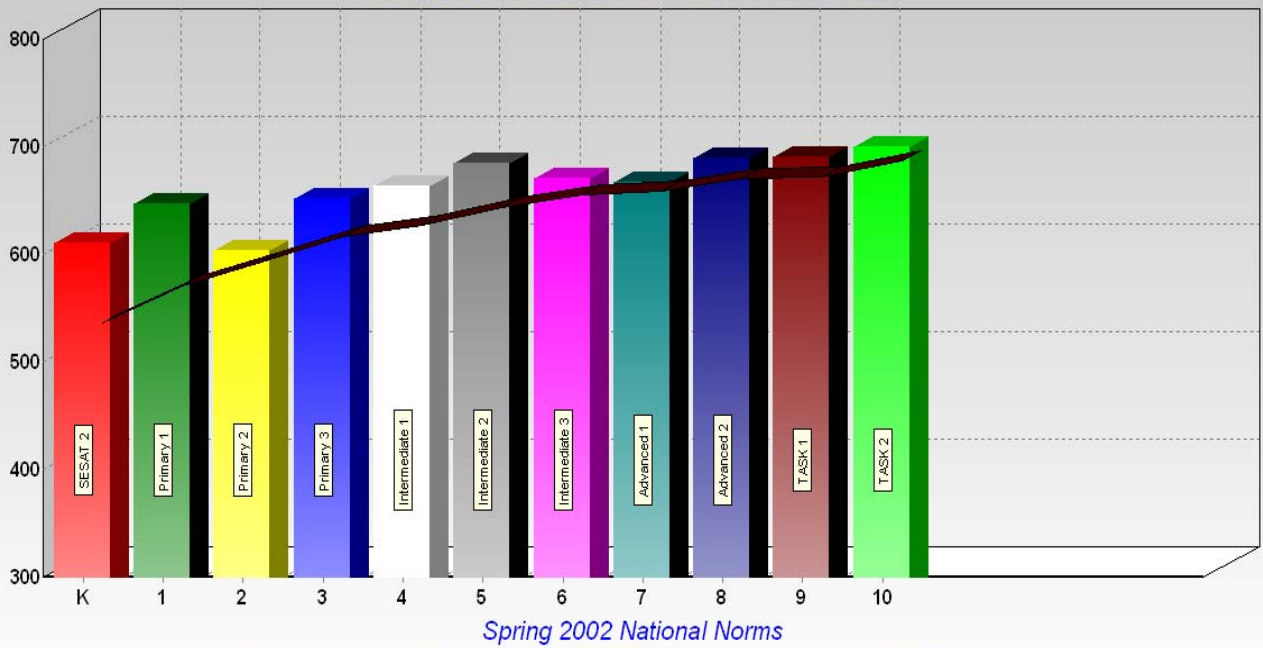
